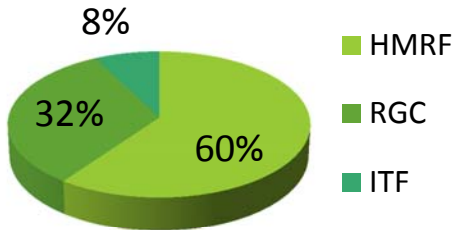

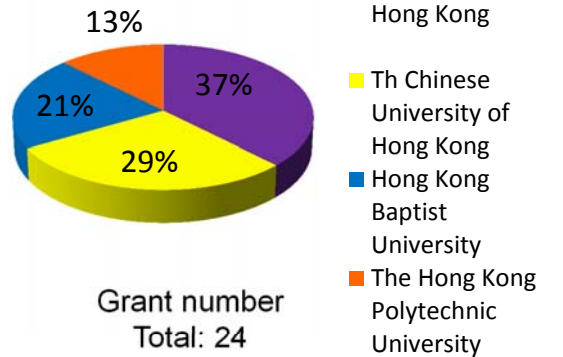

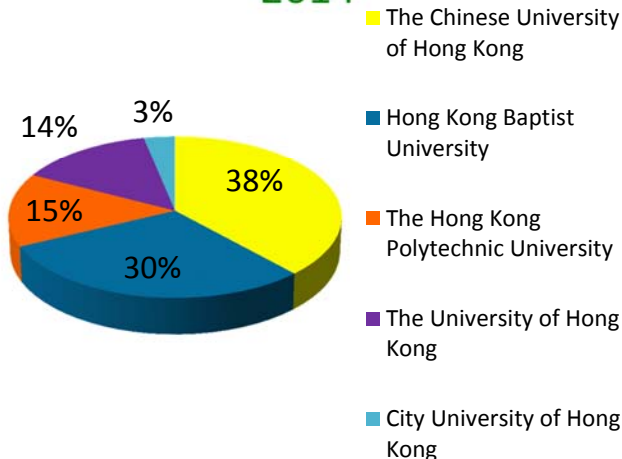

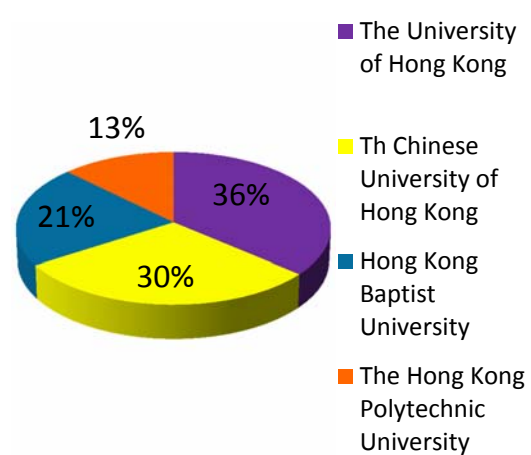

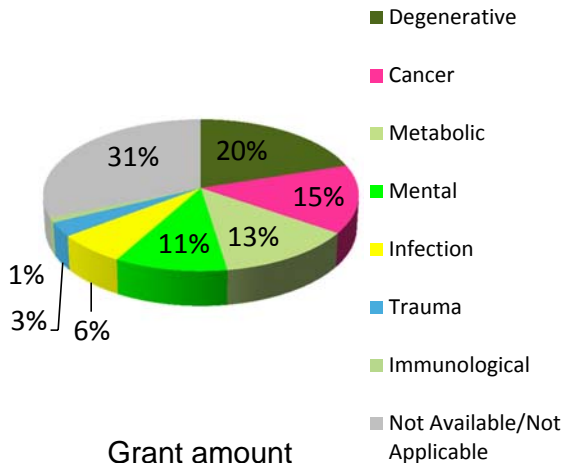

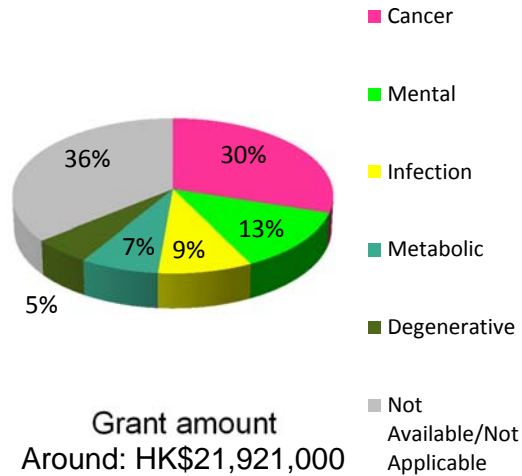
Grant Support Based on Etiology

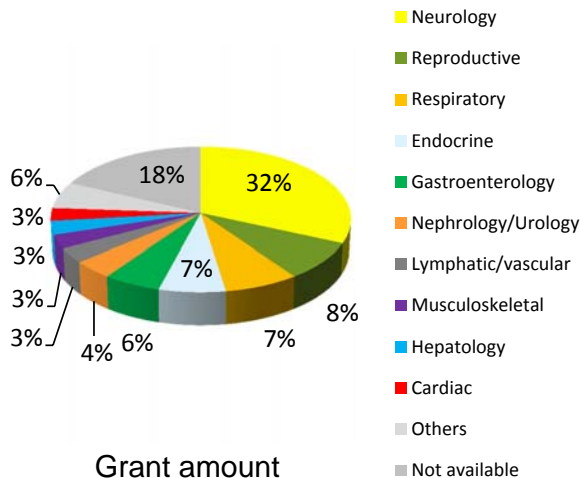

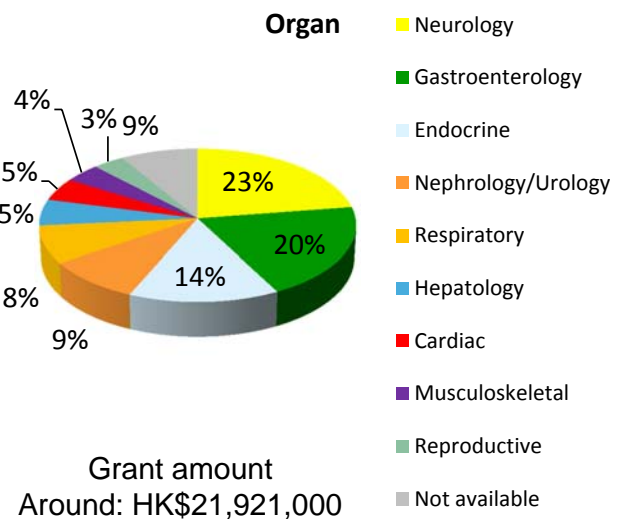
Grant Support Based on Organ Systems

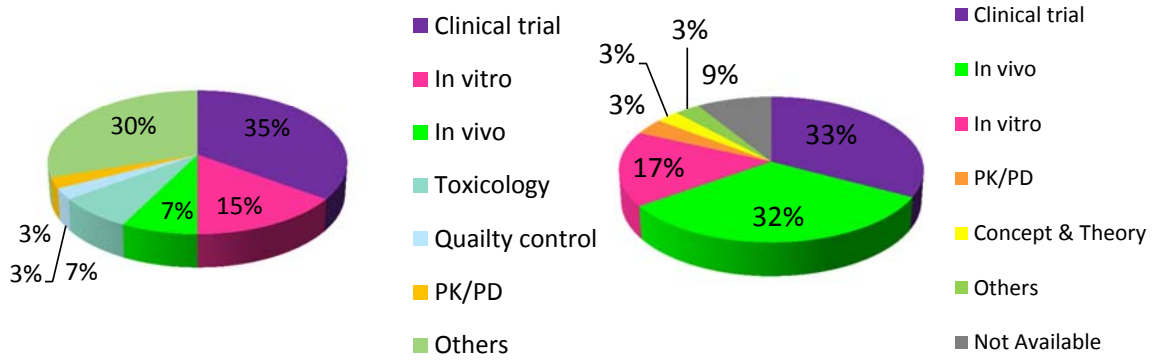

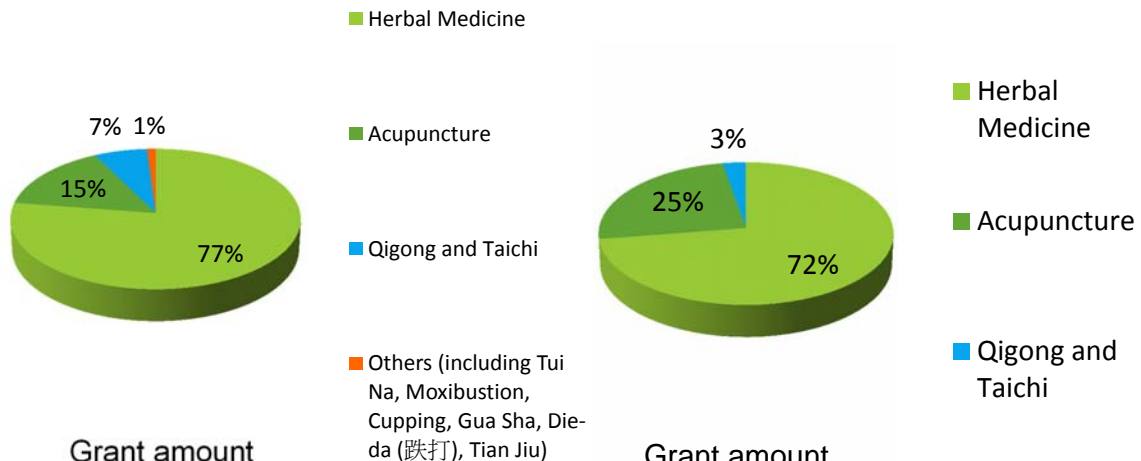

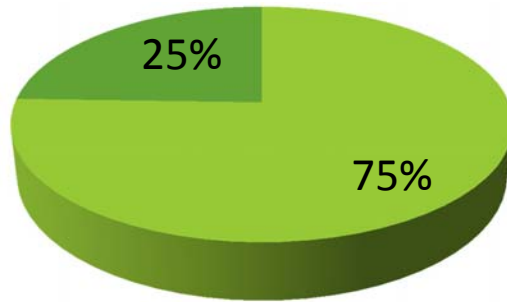

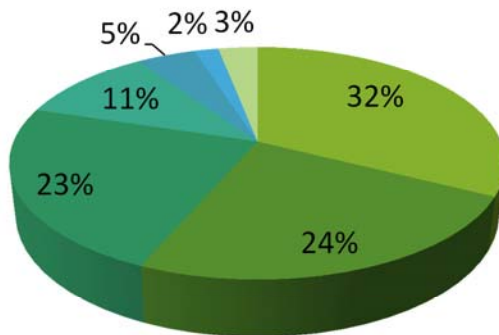

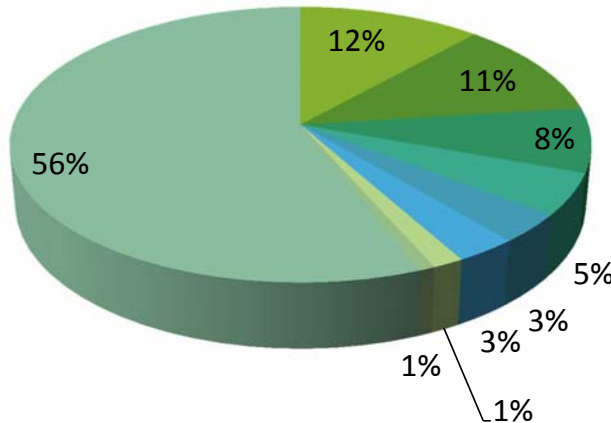

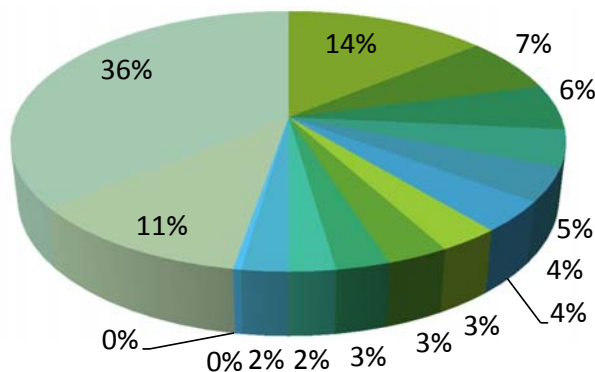

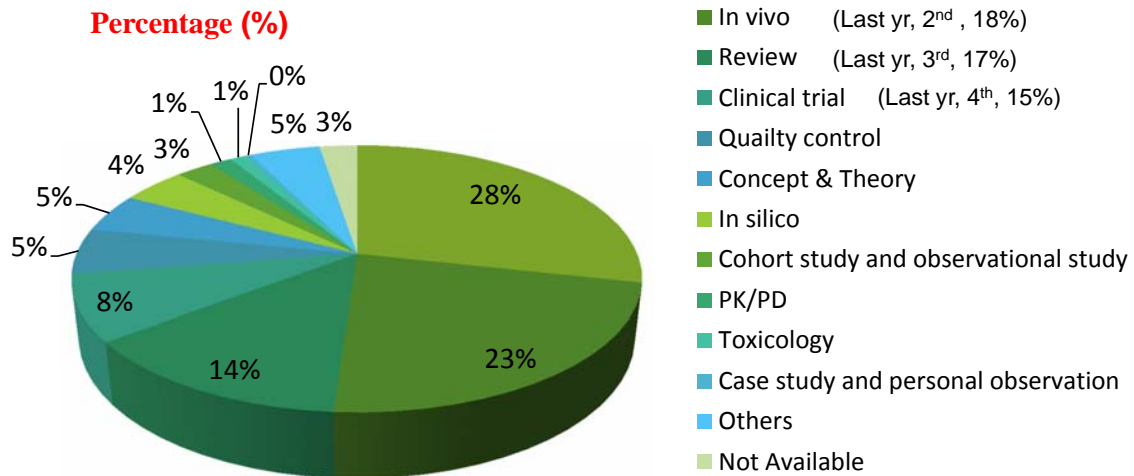

Based on Type of Research



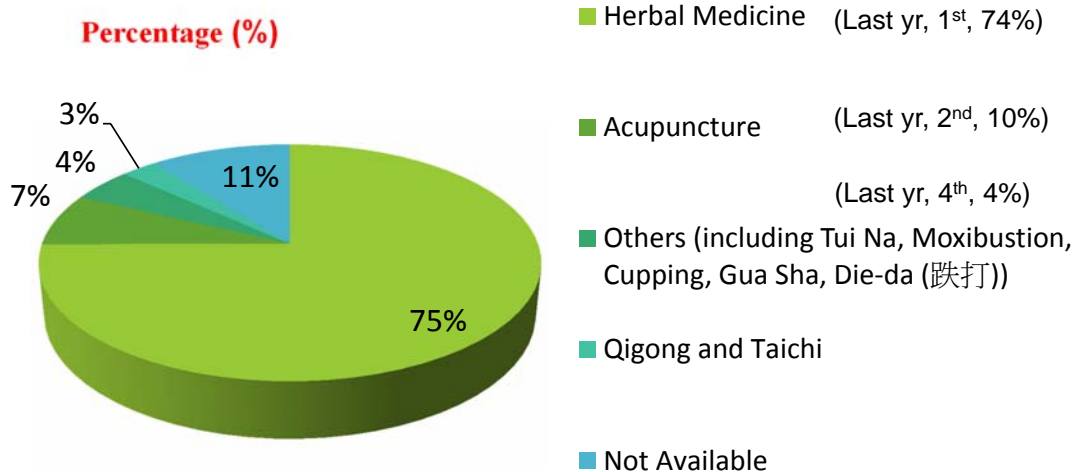

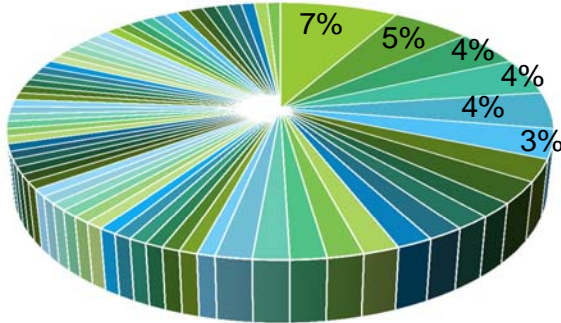

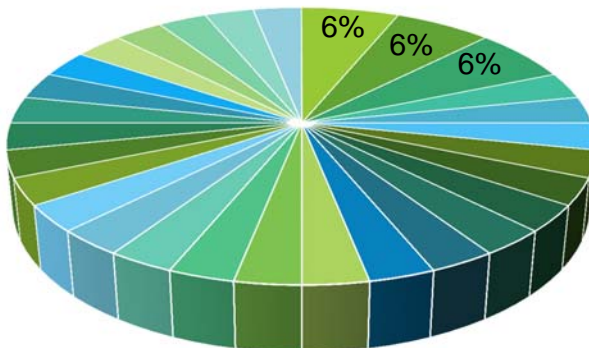

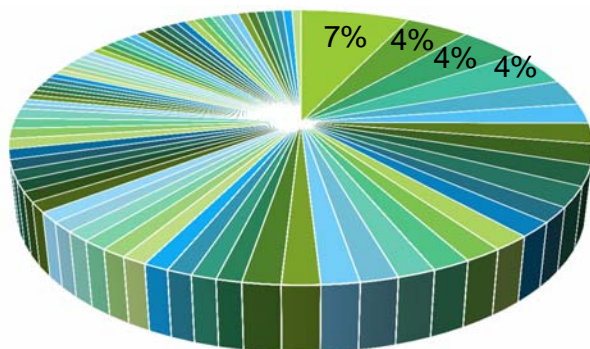

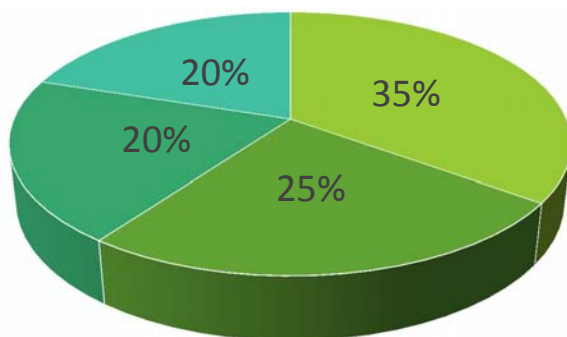

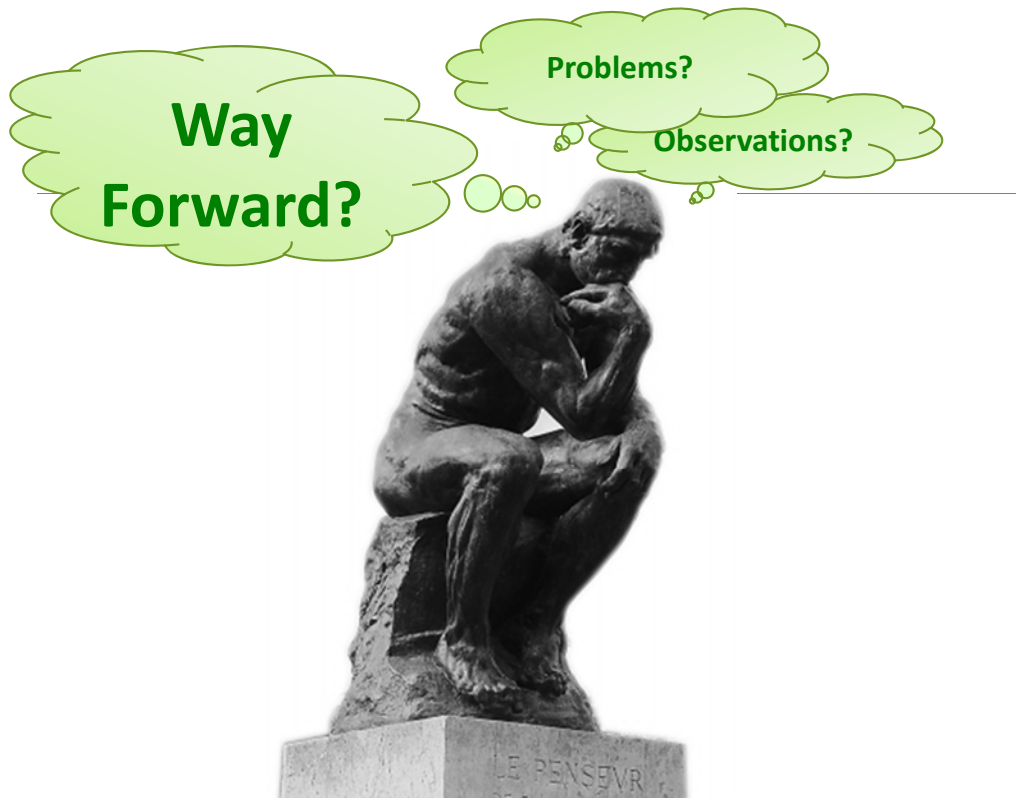
